

MS Nordnorge through Norway's majestic coastline.

April 15th to April 23rd, 2017
(Sailing April 17th to 22nd, 2017)

Beginning high above the Arctic Circle in Kirkenes, we then sail down along the fjord filled coast of Norway calling on exquisite ports of call including Trondheim – Norway's first Capital, the North Cape, and finishing in the beautiful UNESCO Hanseatic port of Bergen.

Our spring voyage is like no other. This is the best time to witness the 'Arctic Awakening'. We will experience 3 seasons in 1 – from the arctic winter climate in Kirkenes down to the spring/summer climates in Bergen; and only the spring itinerary visits the stunning Lyngenfjord – where we can witness millions of migrating birds returning to the Arctic Coast.

Day 1 – April 15 OSLO

Upon arrival, a Flytoget train ticket will be provided for you to transfer to Oslo Sentrum station. From the rail station, it is a few minutes' walk to your hotel. After check in, we will then be taken on a guided city tour. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure.

At the hotel you will receive Guest of Honor Cards along with information folders. The Guest of Honor Cards will allow you free admission to attractions and museums.

Day 2 – April 16 OSLO – KIRKENES (B)

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Gardemoen airport for our flight to Kirkenes. Upon arrival in Kirkenes we will participate in a Husky Adventure, experience the Gabba Reindeer park and visit the Snow Hotel in Kirkenes. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure. (Breakfast)

Day 3 – April 17 KIRKENES / EMBARKATION (B,L,D)

After breakfast, you will be picked up from hotel and transferred to the cruise centre to board your ship Hurtigruten.

10:30am – Transfer to Pier

12:30pm – Depart Kirkenes

In the afternoon the ship docks in Vardø, Norway's easternmost port. Weather permitting, we may invite you to experience ice bathing in the Arctic Ocean! Local divers will display and lecture about the life in the ocean out on deck.

Day 4 – April 18 HAMMERFEST – TROMSØ (B,L,D)

Our next stop, Hammerfest, was founded in 1789, and in its time was Norway's polar capital, acting as a base for hunting expeditions to the high Arctic. In the majestic Lyngen Alps area we sometimes rendezvous with a local shrimp trawler. Our next stop will be Tromsø, where you can enjoy The Arctic Cathedral whilst attending an optional midnight concert.

Day 5 – April 19 VESTERALEN – LOFOTEN ISLANDS (B,L,D)

The Vesterålen and Lofoten Islands are amongst today's highlights. In the morning we transit Risøyrenna, a channel that was specially made for Hurtigruten. You continue through the narrow Raftsund, the picturesque channel between the Vesterålen and Lofoten Islands, where you'll take a detour into the spectacular Trollfjord where steep cliffs hug the ship's sides (time and weather permitting). Here you can also join our optional spectacular Sea Eagle Safari.

Day 6 – April 20 ARCTIC CIRCLE (B,L,D)

The Helgeland coast with its hundreds of islets, fertile farmland and steep granite walls is rich in local lore. Legends include that of the Seven Sisters - a row of mountain peaks, and of how an arrow fired by the troll Hestmannen formed the hole in Torghatten mountain.

Day 7 – April 21 TRONDHEIM – KRISTIANSUND (B,L,D)

Leaving Trondheim in the morning, passing the islands of Munkholmen and Hitra, we stop at Kristiansund, then cross the open sea to Molde, known as the 'city of roses' with its unusually rich, lush plant life courtesy of its Gulf Stream location.

Day 8 – April 22 BERGEN / DISEMBARKATION (B,L)

This morning, you still have a few nautical miles of fascinating scenery ahead. We sail through the Bergen archipelago before arriving in Bergen itself, which has given its visitors a warm welcome for more than 900 years.

Disembark and Transfer to Hotel

Transfer from port to hotel. At the hotel you will receive Guest of Honor Cards along with information folders. The Guest of Honor Cards will allow you free admission to attractions and museums. This afternoon you will have a guided walking tour of the city centre and the main attractions.

Day 9 – April 23 DEPART BERGEN

After Breakfast this morning we will have some free time then take our transfer to the airport for your flight home
